Age groups: 7-10 years, 11-14 years, 15-18 years.

Description:

The contestants will be invited to try their hand at the digital art- computer graphics.

Topic for 2018: Space Science and Technology

Requirements to works:

- works should meet principles of humanism and tolerance;
- personal data of the authors (in English and in the mother tongue of the participating country) must be included into an accompanying doc. file containing:
 - full name and age of the author;
 - address, telephone, e-mail;
 - title of the work;
 - full name of the teacher (if relevant), contact details;
- the works must be sent in the following format options: jpeg.

Organization of the contest:

Each work is to be evaluated by independent judges according to the following criteria:

- conformity to the topic;
- artistic and technical execution.
- ingenuity.

The judges will determine winners within each age group.

The works will be accepted during a period between March 01 and March 31, 2018 only on the official website: **beautifulplanet.top**

Prizes and Awards:

- The Grand Prix is the main award. It will be given for the best work, independent of the age groups;
- the authors winning 1 places in each age group will receive Winner's Certificates (in jpeg format) and prizes;
- the authors winning 2-3 places in each age group will receive Winner's Certificates (in jpeg format);

Follow up:

The organizers retain the right to use the works submitted to participate in the contest for the purposes of education and popularization of aerospace achievements, promotion of museum work, including illustrations in books and albums with names of the authors provided. The works may be added to the museum collections of the national coordinators of the contest.
